Degree Requirements (45 Hours)

All candidates must complete 21 hours of graduate course work focusing specifically on their respective language and specific languageteaching area, and 24 hours of graduate course work in professional education more generally, as well as fulfill all other requirements for Class I licensure. Course work in a respective language should cover a range of topics in the areas of linguistics, literature, culture, and the teaching of the respective language, and should be taken in consultation with the student's academic advisor in order to prepare for the MAT comprehensive exam.
