Learning Outcomes

1. Students will demonstrate near-native linguistic competence in Spanish as it pertains to all graduate courses (including all examinations) that are part of the Program of Study.
2. Students will produce original research on the literature and cultures of Spain, Latin America and the Hispanic cultures around the world, both orally and in writing at a near-native level of stylistic, critical and theoretical discourse.
3. Students will conduct research and produce original scholarship within a specific theoretical and critical framework.
4. Doctoral Candidates will present original papers at conferences (and eventually submit their scholarship for publication), submit manuscripts for future publication, and be encouraged to write pertinent grant proposals.
