2. Acting students will demonstrate the ability to express artistic choices of dramatic action and character development through the written documentation and performance presentations in the department's theatre production program.
3. Design students will demonstrate the ability to express artistic choices of production design in scenery, costumes, and lighting through the written documentation, oral presentations, and production presentations in the department's theatre production program.
