

WOMEN'S AND GENDER STUDIES, CERTIFICATE

The Certificate of Graduate Study in Women's and Gender Studies is interdisciplinary and requires a total of 18 graduate credits within a six-year period in prescribed and elective courses.

Learning Outcomes

1. Students will apply feminist theory and methods in their scholarly and/or community work.
2. Students will examine the intersections of gender race class and other categories of social difference as they apply to individuals or groups.
3. Students will demonstrate an engagement with their profession and the local and larger community.
