

# **BUSINESS ANALYTICS, M.S.**

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Requirements for admission to the program conform to the general regulations of The Graduate School and the accreditation standards of the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business. Admission decisions are based on a review of standardized test score performance (GMAT/GRE), professional experience, previous scholastic performance, professional recommendations, a clear statement of purpose and, in some cases, a personal interview. The GMAT/GRE requirement may be waived for applicants with superior performance in their undergraduate studies and/or significant related previous work experience. Preference will be given to STEM majors or applicants with strong quantitative backgrounds, especially those with a Business Minor. Applicants are also expected to have at least one semester of calculus.

Applicants whose native language is not English are required to submit a satisfactory score on the TOEFL, the IELTS Intl. Academic Course Type 2 exam, TOEIC, or the PTE Academic. This requirement may be waived if the applicant has graduated from a degree program taught in English.
