

CYBERSECURITY MANAGEMENT, CERTIFICATE

The purpose of offering the certificate is to add richness to existing master's degrees by helping the student identify, understand, and mitigate cyber risks. Successful students should be well equipped to coordinate between senior management and the information technology specialists.

Degree Requirements (12 Hours)

The certificate will require 12 credits: 3 credits from the single core course and 9 credits from elective courses.
