

SUSTAINABILITY IN BUSINESS, CERTIFICATE

Admissions

The Sustainability in Business Certificate will be open to all graduate students at USC (primarily graduate students in the Moore School of Business).

Candidates who possess the following credentials may generally consider themselves competitive for admission to the Graduate Sustainability in Business Certificate.

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with a GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale for all coursework completed beyond high school.
- A basic understanding of business concepts.
- A professional background in business, engineering, environmental science, law, public health, or sustainability is beneficial but not required.
- For international applicants, a TOEFL score of 95 or higher, or an IELTS score of 7.0 or higher.

Each application is evaluated by the admissions committee, which makes an official recommendation to the Graduate School. The Graduate School makes the final decision and notifies the applicant of the decision.
