Students pursuing any graduate degree can add the 12 credit hour certificate on to their program of study. In addition, certificate holders will help businesses and other institutions implement sustainable business practices in South Carolina and beyond. This should enhance their ability to effect positive environmental and social change in business in our state and region.
