Admission

All applicants admitted to the Informatics Ph.D. program must meet the general requirements for admission to The Graduate School at the time of application. In addition, international applicants must provide an English language proficiency exam score unless they come from a country where English is an official language and are specifically exempt, according to The Graduate School policy. Admissions are competitive. An admissions scorecard will be used to evaluate applicants, weighing the applicant's undergraduate GPA, GRE scores or GMAT scores, reference letters, previous academic and professional experience, and a career goal statement.
