

# SPECIALIZED STUDY IN INFORMATION SCIENCE, CERTIFICATE

## Certificate Requirements (12 Hours)

For the Certificate of Specialized Study in Information Science degree, an approved Program of Study with 12 semester hours of graduate course work must be completed with a minimum grade point ratio of 3.00 (B) overall. In partial fulfillment of the requirements for graduation, each student will submit an electronic portfolio documenting learning and professional growth during the Certificate program.

Students will select a total of four courses (12 credit hours) in consultation with their academic advisor. Each student's program of study will be tailored according to prior course work and the student's professional objectives. ISCI 794: Internship in Library and Information Science may be taken as part of the certificate.

## End-of-Program Portfolio

In their final semester, students will submit an end-of-program portfolio as part of the requirements for completing the Certificate of Specialized Study in Information Science. Students concurrently earning the certificate and the MLIS will submit a single portfolio with an additional required section specifically addressing the certificate.
