

FAMILY NURSE PRACTITIONER, CERTIFICATE

The Family Nurse Practitioner, Certificate of Graduate Study (post-master's certificate) is restricted to students who hold a master's degree in nursing. The program of study is designed to augment the student's prior graduate study through advanced practice preparation to provide direct patient management in primary care across the lifespan in many settings. Graduates are employed in a variety of primary care settings ranging from federally qualified health centers, urban and rural family practice/primary care practices.

This curriculum prepares nurses to sit for national certification as Family Nurse Practitioner.
