

NURSING INFORMATICS, CERTIFICATE

The Certificate of Graduate Study (post-master's certificate) in Nursing Informatics (N.I.) is for students who hold a master's degree in nursing and seek additional preparation in the management of information and technology to improve health care quality, patient safety, efficiency, and patient outcomes. Nursing informatics integrates nursing science, computer science, and informatics science to manage and communicate data, information, knowledge and wisdom in nursing practice. Graduates of the program may be eligible to sit for certification examination in nursing informatics.
