## TRAUMA-INFORMED PRACTICE, CERTIFICATE

## **Admissions Criteria**

It is each applicant's responsibility to ensure that all required application materials are received. Applicants should list the Graduate Certificate in Trauma-Informed Practice on the application under degree pursued. The program accepts applications on a rolling basis.

## **Currently Enrolled Students in the Master of Social Work Program**

Students in good academic standing may request concurrent enrollment. Interested students must contact the program coordinator to review the application process.

## **Other Applicants**

Applicants not currently enrolled in the Master of Social Work program, must submit the following for full consideration:

- A completed application with all requested information and supporting documents supplied.
- Official transcripts showing all college-level course work attempted and the award of the baccalaureate or higher degree from an accredited college or university.
- 3. At least two letters of recommendation
- 4. International applicants whose native language is not English are also required to submit a satisfactory score on an approved language proficiency test.
