

TRAUMA-INFORMED PRACTICE, CERTIFICATE

Admissions Criteria

It is each applicant's responsibility to ensure that all required application materials are received. Applicants should list the Graduate Certificate in Trauma-Informed Practice on the application under degree pursued. The program accepts applications on a rolling basis.

Currently Enrolled Students in the Master of Social Work Program

Students in good academic standing may request concurrent enrollment. Interested students must contact the program coordinator to review the application process.

Other Applicants

Applicants not currently enrolled in the Master of Social Work program, must submit the following for full consideration:

1. A completed application with all requested information and supporting documents supplied.
2. Official transcripts showing all college-level course work attempted and the award of the baccalaureate or higher degree from an accredited college or university.
3. At least two letters of recommendation
4. International applicants whose native language is not English are also required to submit a satisfactory score on an approved language proficiency test.
