Admission to the Professional Program

All University teacher education students must apply and be admitted to Professional Program/Internship at mid-point(s) in their programs prior to final internship (i.e. student teaching). Requirements for admission vary by program, but for undergraduate students include 60 credit hours with a minimum overall GPA of 2.75, successful completion of a state-approved basic skills examination. Students in the BA in Special education must also complete EDTE 201, EDFI 300, EDPY 401 and EDEX 523 with a grade of C or better.
